



On Saturday 19 October, 65 volunteers got together to discuss riding, driving and Observing!


The event was well supported by Groups in Northern Ireland and they were joined by

The most recent data release, published in late September 2024, saw 1,624 fatalities and 29,711 KSI's – every one of these deaths is preventable, so while we welcome an overall reduction in deaths over the last year, there is plenty of work to do to reduce From this data we also saw some worrying trends – most notably an increase in the proportion of fatalities where an occupant is not wearing a seatbelt which has risen from a fifth in 2022 to a quarter of those killed in a vehicle in 2023 in this recent
