Motorcycle Skills Day - Machine Handling: Joining Instructions

Welcome to the IAM RoadSmart Machine Handling Event. These instructions are essential to ensure a smooth and safe experience. Please read carefully and act accordingly.

Key Requirements

- 1. Read All Instructions Ensure you understand every detail.
- 2. Complete the Online Declaration Use the link in your welcome email.
- 3. Raise Questions Early Contact us at 0300 303 1134 for clarifications.

Arrival

- **Registration opens from 08:00**. Ensure you have signed the Skills Day Declaration sent via email. The main gates are staffed 24/7 but will be open from 08:00 for event participants to access the on-site cafes.
- Compulsory safety briefing at 08:45.
- Please allow plenty of time for your journey to the venue and refuel in advance if necessary.
- Park in the designated area.
- Remove all luggage and loose items from your motorcycle. Secure them in the assigned area.

Group Allocation

Participants will be divided into small groups to enhance learning and safety. You will remain with your assigned group throughout the event.

Machine Preparation

- **Roadworthiness**: Your motorcycle must be fully road legal. Daylight MOTs are not sufficient.
- **Prohibited Actions**: Do not remove or tape up mirrors or conceal the registration plate.

Insurance

- This is not a track day or speed event.
- We advise that you check with your insurance provider to confirm coverage for this type of activity, as opposed to contacting IAM RoadSmart.

Protective Clothing

- It is mandatory to wear full and approved motorcycle protective clothing (leathers or textiles).
- Road legal UK helmets are required (no USA DOT-only helmets). Helmet-mounted cameras are prohibited, but securely mounted machine cameras are allowed.

Catering

- On-site catering will be available from 08:00 for food and drinks.
- You are welcome to bring a packed lunch and refillable drinking bottle. Drinking water is available on-site to minimise plastic waste.

Fuel

- Arrive with a full tank of fuel or fully charged.
- Numerous fuel stations and charge points are available in Bicester.

Event Conduct

This is a Machine Handling Day, not a Track Day. The following rules apply:

- 1. No timing, pace-making, or racing.
- 2. Ride within your capability
- 3. Show respect to all participants.
- 4. Non-compliance will result in a warning and possible exclusion without refund.

Cancellations

If the event is cancelled by the circuit owners (e.g., due to weather), we will aim to reschedule.
