This was most positive and forward-looking and I have invited Peter to attend our Committee Meeting on 4<sup>th</sup> November to see how things are going.

To avoid any possible conflict with my duties as Chair, I have stood down as Chief Observer; Malcolm Ballard has kindly agreed to take on the role and will now oversee the Observers. I hope they will keep in touch with him, their Associates and with Richard. It will not surprise you to learn we have not been advised of any new Associates, although there may be a flood once things return to normal.

The Committee has also cancelled the June Group Night, but are hopeful the September meeting may go ahead, at least in some form. The theme for each of these nights is Meet the Observer; where scenarios faced by Observers will be discussed and, hopefully, some practical sessions. This will obviously be dependent on guidance from above. September also marks the latest time for us to hold our AGM – the rule is that it must be within 18 months of the previous AGM, so the deadline is 12<sup>th</sup> September. The Committee is making plans for a virtual AGM, using email, the website and Zoom. I understand there are high-level discussions to waive the 18-month rule – so the deadline may be extended. As we learn more, we will let you know. We need to notify you 3 weeks before an AGM – whatever format it ends up being!
