Motorcycle Section

Members will be aware of the Continuous Professional Development program, which is intended to encourage rider progression and group participation at Silver, Gold and Masters level. Local Observer Brian Lavery has recently passed his Gold course (congratulations Brian) and three further riders have been in touch to request a Masters taster.

Paul Acres and Brian Dring have been liaising with North West Blood Bikes, at their request, with a view to organising a session to introduce advanced riding to their members and to conduct taster rides during February.

NW Blood Bikes is a voluntary organisation that provides out of hours transportation of urgent medical items such as blood, samples, patient notes, in fact anything that can be carried by motorcycle. They also use a number of car drivers to provide their services.

Approximately 20 of the organisation's members have shown an interest, as well as a number of car volunteers. Brian will pass these onto the car team in due course.

The use of Southport Fire Station for the advanced rider courses looks as though it may resume in the not too distant future. The group is continuing to liaise and it is hoped that things might open before April.
