A Happy New Year to all members and associates and welcome to the first 2023 edition of the SAM flyer.

With new associates signed up for both the car and motorcycle sections, the year is underway for planning and providing our advanced courses. There will be national IAM changes to observer training to a national standard for both sections and arrangements will also be underway to allow these changes to be made by the end of March 2025.

The committee met at the Southport and Birkdale Sports Club on Wednesday 25th January. The group's president, Stella Owen, was a guest at the meeting.

There was much to discuss following on from the final committee of 2022, when the main topic was the group's monthly social events. It had been decided then that no further events would be held for the remainder of the year and that the matter would be addressed in the New Year. More on that later.

The group is always keen to take on new associates and, as a reminder, SAM offers discounts of 50% (that's £87.50) on the course fee to new associates aged 35 and under and 20% (£35) to those aged 36 and over. The section hopes to provide a regular ride out programme during 2023 for all bike members who have passed the advanced test. Observer Dave Mercer is to co-ordinate this and has already sent an email to bike members, inviting them to sign up to a WhatsApp group. The committee discussed the future of social evenings and talks, with concerns that much effort and expense goes into arranging meetings, which are poorly supported. 102 members attended 6 meetings in 2022, which equates to an average of 17 in attendance, although some meetings achieved less that this. There had been a very limited response to the summer BBQ, this being subsequently cancelled.
