Welcome to the November edition of the flyer, now being prepared by John Dickens.

The Sefton Advanced Motorists' monthly meeting, held at the Southport and Birkdale Sport and Social Club on Monday 15th November, saw a fantastic turn out of 40 members and associates for the 'Meet The Examiner' session with IAM examiner, Dennis Nicholson. In addition to his 30 years in the police, during which he was an advanced rider, Dennis has been an examiner for the IAM for 17 years and also provides the same service for ROSPA.

Dennis talked about what he is looking for when testing associate members for both the car and motorcycle sections, including the preparation and planning by associates for the test, as well as the various aspects of the IAM course. Dennis answered numerous questions from the group, all of which provided for a very interesting and informative evening.

The committee held this month's meeting at the Southport & Birkdale Club on Wednesday 17th November. Alan Wilde, Chair, passed on his thanks to members and associates for the good turnout at the monthly meeting on Monday.

New Car and Bike section shirts have been ordered for observers and committee members, along with amended badges, which were shown to the committee.

The committee discussed a matter that was raised by Ken Standring at the Monthly meeting, being that of the no entry signage at each end of Queens Road in Southport. Ken has been in correspondence with Cambridge Ward councillors and the committee will await any reply.

Other matters discussed included the return to the committee of Rob Simpson and the SAM website is in the process of being updated.

Members should also be aware that the committee has agreed that, as an incentive for potential associates, the 2021 discounts on courses should continue into 2022. These were first raised in the meeting and flyer of last January and offer 50:20:10 discounts - For 35's and under, 50% (\pounds 75*) of your course fee is paid back from the group on completion of training. If 36 and over, 20% (\pounds 30*) will be paid back. All drivers and riders are eligible for a free taster drive or ride before joining and this qualifies for a 10% discount (\pounds 15*), applied by the IAM when signing up.

Christmas Party

As mentioned in the October flyer, the magician, Peter Turner, has been booked for the Christmas Party, to be held at the S & B Club at **7.45pm on 20th December 2021**. This will be a 'cabaret' style event, with tables.
