**Report from Paul Acres, Bike Chief Observer.** Given the winter weather and the instability that snow chains bring to motorcycles the group has curtailed it's on road activities but is busy planning for 2025. The training group met in January. A meeting of all observers will be held in February to review its systems and to set its programmes for the next 12 months. A group of willing volunteer observers has been formed to structure a formal programme of social rideouts during the year.

The next course is scheduled to start on 1.3.25. To date 7 associates have enrolled to take it. 3 riders from previous advanced courses who suspended training for various personal reasons will join the spring course to complete their training.

**CPD Gold diploma** One member who has completed the course awaits assessment and one other member has asked to join the course later in the year.

Bikesafe The group will continue to support Bikesafe through this year.

**New developments** The group has expressed an interest in becoming a pilot group to test new computerised run sheets which the IAMR propose to introduce this year. A final



decision on whether or not to join the pilot will be made in discussion with the IAMR once the systems have been fully developed. At a recent meeting of the Northwest Regional Forum the group proposed there should be a system of exchanging best practice between groups. Our ASDM strongly supported that proposal and has said that he will organise meetings to discuss this. In advance of that we have already met with the Chief observer of the Warrington group to exchange information about our systems.

Retired Lancashire police officer,

Mebs was an incredibly shy boy from rural Pakistan fulfilling his dream of living in England. Sadly the new environment failed to remove the psychological barriers created by his fear of life and people. He failed at school and wasn't good enough for a career in football. He settled for jobs he didn't like and agreed to marriage.

He then meets someone who helped change his life. Eventually he joined Lancashire Constabulary, not necessarily an easy choice for an Asian man. He became a community officer and then a minority ethnic communities liaison officer. He learns about discrimination and how to support others. Mebs later became Chair of the Lancashire Black Police Association, a role which took up 50% of his working time.

After leaving the police he became a diversity and unconscious bias trainer, author and speaker.
