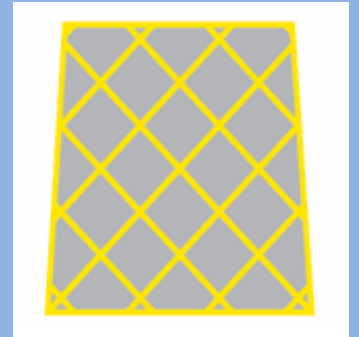

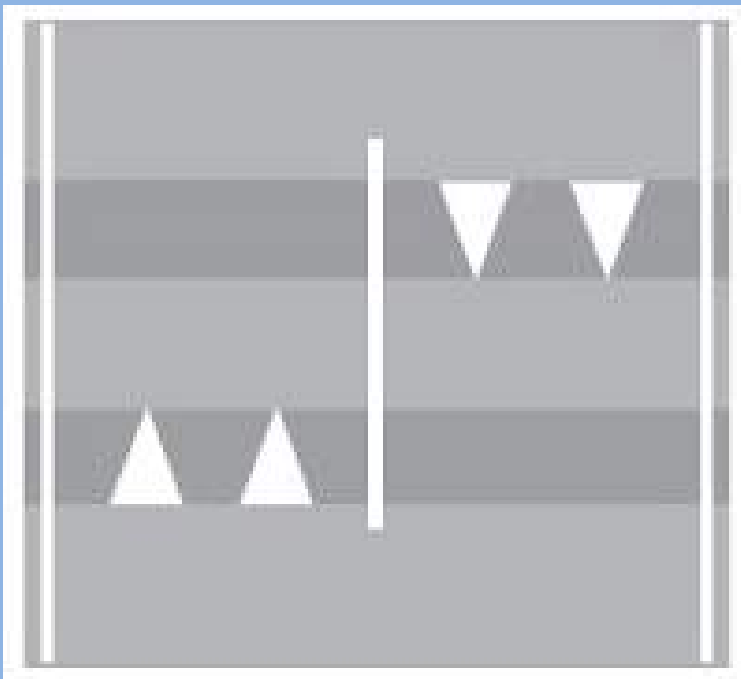

# Round 1 Highway Code

Q1

When can you legally drive without wearing a seat belt?

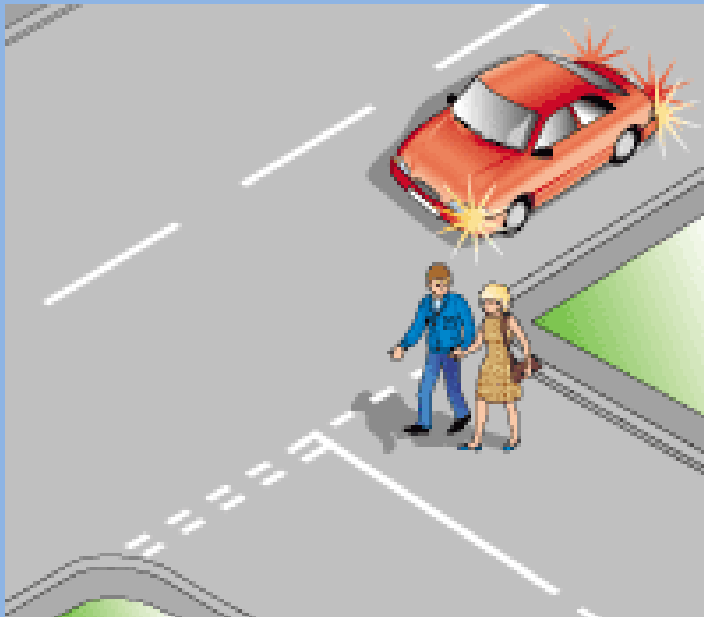
You don't need to wear a seat belt if you are:

- a driver who is reversing, or supervising a learner driver who is reversing in a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue services
- a passenger in a trade vehicle and you're investigating a fault
- driving a goods vehicle on deliveries that is travelling no more than 50 metres between stops
- a licensed taxi driver who is 'plying for hire' or carrying passengers
- Medical Exemption Certificate

Q2

What action should you take turning left?



Rule 146

Take extra care at junctions. You should

- watch out for cyclists, motorcyclists and pedestrians as they are not always easy to see
- watch out for pedestrians crossing a road into which you are turning. **If they have started to cross they have priority, so give way.**



# Round 1 Highway Code

Q3

When must sidelights be used?

Sidelights must be switched on between sunset and sunrise even in brightly lit areas

when your car is parked on a road (or a lay-by on a road) where the speed limit is greater than 30mph

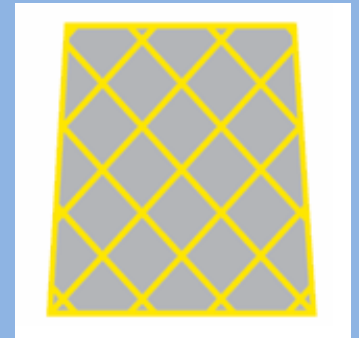


# Round 1 Highway Code

Q4

When can you enter a yellow box junction?

You **MUST NOT** enter the box until your exit road or lane is clear. However, you may enter the box and wait when you want to turn right, and are only stopped from doing so by oncoming traffic, or by other vehicles waiting to turn right. At signalled roundabouts you **MUST NOT** enter the box unless you can cross over it completely without stopping

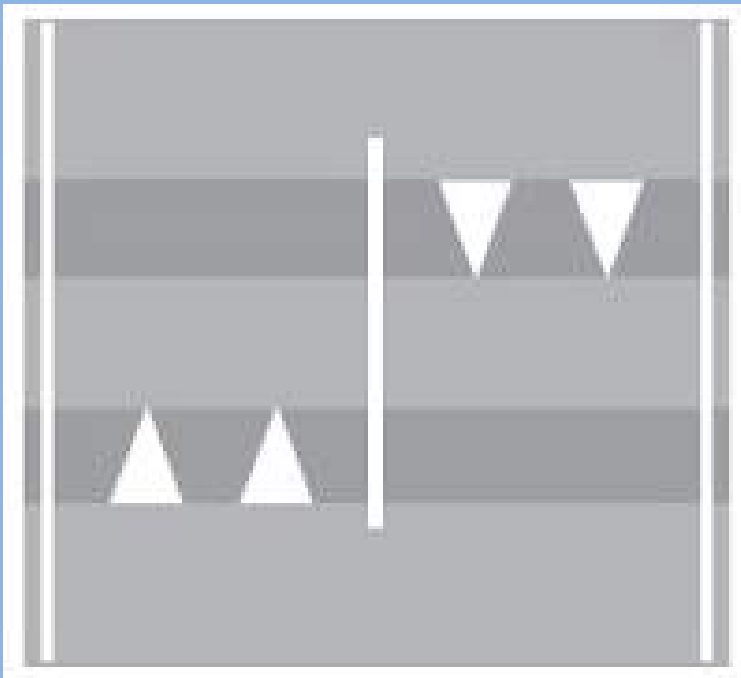

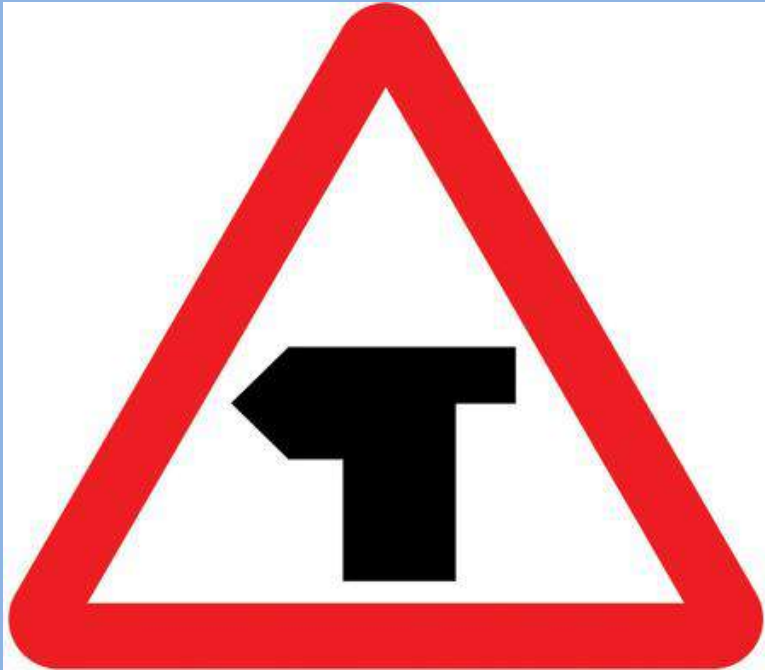

# Round 1 Highway Code

Q9

How many different coloured studs on motorways and dual carriageways ... ..5

**White** studs mark the lanes or the middle of the road.

**Red** studs mark the left edge of the road.

**Amber** studs mark the central reservation of a dual carriageway or motorway.

**Green** studs mark the edge of the main carriageway at lay-bys and slip roads.

**Green/yellow** studs indicate temporary adjustments to lane layouts, e.g. where road works are taking place.

# Round 2 Roadcraft

Q1

Fixed – road junctions, roundabouts

Moving – other vehicles, people, bicycles, horses

Variable – weather conditions



# Round 2 Roadcraft

Q2

Enter the bend too fast

Apply too much power in the bend

Steer too sharply



# Round 2 Roadcraft

Q3

What are the 4 key principles for safe cornering?

Your vehicle should be in the correct position on the approach

You should be travelling at the correct speed for the corner or bend

Correct gear for the speed

Should be able to stop safely within the distance you can see to be clear



# Round 2 Roadcraft

Q4

What effect on braking does doubling your speed have?

Quadruples the braking distance

Concentrating on a specific point and being oblivious to the surrounding

The ability to vary vehicle speed in response to changing road and traffic conditions by the accurate use of the accelerator

Driving too fast
